6. Accommodation:

7. Meals:

The National Footvolley Federation provides all meals which includes breakfast, lunch and dinner. Dinner of the 16th and breakfast of the 20th are included.

8. Transfers:

It is advised that the flights have as destination the Faro airport, located 30 km from Albufeira. The organization, with the partnership of a transfers company, will take responsibility for the transfer from the airport to Albufeira.

As alternative, the flights can have as destination the Lisbon airport, located at 300 Km of Albufeira. The athletes should then head to the Gare do Oriente train station (Taxi- 5 min), and catch the train to Albufeira, approximately 3 hours. The organization takes responsibility for the transfer from the Albufeira train station to the hotel.

The National Footvolley Federation takes responsibility for the transfers after the event as well.
